• During the Users Office working hours (weekdays 9:00–17:30), users may use the Resting Room for bed rental or receive basic first aid, depending on the situation.

In the subsection <u>Overview of the Resting Rooms</u>, the current text is replaced with the updated version as follows.

[Current]

- There are two Resting Rooms available in Sub-Entrance Hall 2.
- Both Resting Room 1 and 2 can be used freely as break areas, even by those not experiencing injuries or health issues.
- Partitioned areas are available for changing clothes.
- Resting Room 1 is designated for women, and Resting Room 2 is designated for men.
- Only beverages and snacks may be consumed inside. Meals are not allowed.
- Users must maintain cleanliness in the Resting Rooms.

[Updated]

* Use of the Rest Room as a Break Area Has Been Prohibited Since August 2025.

- There are two rest rooms located at Sub-Entrance 2 (Room 1 for women, Room 2 for men).
- These rooms are available for rest in case of physical discomfort or for first aid treatment in the event of injury. Please contact the Users Office (022-785-9898; security staff will respond during nights, weekends, and holidays) before use.
- In addition, the rooms may be used for short periods for purposes such as changing clothes.
- Please set the door sign to "In Use" while using the room, and return it to "Vacant" after use.
- When the door sign indicates "In Use," entry is prohibited to anyone other than authorized personnel.
- Only beverages may be consumed inside the room; eating is strictly prohibited.
- Please maintain cleanliness and hygiene inside the room.
- For safety management purposes, NanoTerasu staff may enter the room to check the situation. We appreciate your understanding in advance.

In the subsection <u>First Aid in the Resting Rooms</u>, the current text is replaced with the updated version as follows.

[Current]

If a minor injury occurs during an experiment or if a user feels unwell, they may contact the Users Office during working hours (weekdays 9:00–17:30). A nurse may provide assistance in the

Resting Room, depending on the severity of the condition. A first-aid kit is available near the entrance of the Resting Room. Users may use it as needed for basic first aid.

[Updated]

If a minor injury occurs during an experiment or if you feel unwell, a nurse may respond in the Resting Room depending on your symptoms or condition, provided it is during weekday working hours (9:00–17:30). Please contact the Users Office. A first-aid kit is available near the entrance of the Resting Room. Users may use it as needed for basic first aid.
